Taking the Blessed Sacrament (a Consecrated Host, housed in a ¶Luna!) from the Tabernacle, the presider (Priest or Deacon) wearing an alb, stole, and cope, places the Luna in the Monstrance.

Exposition of the Holy Eucharist, either in a ciborium or in a monstrance, leads us to acknowledge Christ's marvelous presence in the sacrament and invites us to the spiritual union with him that culminates in sacramental communion. In such exposition care must therefore be taken that everything brings out the meaning of eucharistic worship in correlation with the Mass. Exposition Holy Eucharist - Liturgy Office

Exposition of the holy eucharist, either in the ciborium or in the monstrance, is intended to acknowledge Christ's marvellous presence in the sacrament. Exposition invites us to the spiritual union with him that culminates in sacramental communion. Thus it fosters very well the worship which is due to Christ in spirit and in truth.

Holy Communion and Worship of the Eucharist Outside Mass

¶In the Eucharist, the Son of God comes to meet us and desires to become one with us; eucharistic adoration is simply the natural consequence of the eucharistic celebration, which is itself the Church's supreme act of adoration. ¶Receiving the Eucharist means adoring Him whom we receive.

A period of exposition blurs the boundary between formal liturgy and informal devotion. The Church offers very few rules for what can or cannot be done during the period of adoration. But it is noteworthy that the Church:

Celebrant's Guides: Benediction

During the exposition there may be prayers, songs, readings from Scripture, and a brief homily to direct the attention of the faithful to the worship of the Lord. Benediction Toward the end of the exposition the priest goes to the altar, genuflects, and kneels. Then the following or another suitable eucharistic song is sung. Tantum ergo Sacramentum

Eucharist Adoration and Benediction

Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament, also called Benediction with the Blessed Sacrament or the Rite of Eucharistic Exposition and Benediction, is a devotional ceremony, celebrated especially in the Roman Catholic Church, but also in some other Christian traditions such as Anglo-Catholicism, whereby a bishop, priest, or a deacon blesses the congregation with the Eucharist at the end of a period of adoration.
